Aeris is the 100% owner and operator of the Tritton Copper Operations, located near the towns of Nyngan and Cobar in New South Wales.

The Tritton Copper Operations' mining complex includes two underground mines, the +20Mt deposit Tritton mine and the +10Mt deposit Murrawombie mine, and the 1.8 million tonne per annum Tritton processing plant. There are four additional mine projects scheduled for future production which, together with Tritton and Murrawombie, form the current Life of Mine plan.

Copper is extracted via conventional crushing and flotation circuits producing a copper concentrate. Stope production at Tritton commenced in March 2005 and additional upgrades to the ventilation circuit were completed in 2017 to sustain ore production at more than one million tonnes per annum. This investment, together with changes to the mining sequence, have set Tritton up for stable stope production as mining extends at depth.

Within the highly prospective 2,160 km² Tritton tenement package, more than 750,000 tonnes of copper has been discovered.
