Constellation delivers major milestone

We have announced the maiden open pit Ore Reserve Estimate for our Constellation deposit at Tritton Operations - an exciting step forward for Aeris.

The Open Pit Probable Ore Reserve of 2.3Mt @ 2.0% Cu, 0.6g/t Au and 3g/t Ag supports a 5 to 7 year mine life, with even more potential underground. This project strengthens our position in a market hungry for copper, gold, and silver, and leverages existing Tritton infrastructure to keep costs low and efficiency high. It's a significant achievement that reflects the hard work and expertise of our team - and it's just the beginning. Studies are already underway to explore deeper opportunities.

Strengthening relationships for effective emergency response

Safety is a team effort, and we recently hosted an Emergency Services Day to strengthen partnerships with local responders. Sixteen representatives from fire, ambulance, and mutual aid mine rescue teams joined us on site for a full tour, including our emergency shed, response systems, and Northern underground operations.

Constellation Project moves forward

We have been focusing on optimising mine design and preparing for construction.

We welcomed the Girilambone community to a Constellation update on Wednesday 26 November 2025. Jason Hughes and Roy Sharma discussed ongoing work on the Constellation Project, and our focus on site layout, mine services (water/power) and technical studies to optimise mine design. The technical studies weigh up different pit sizes and their interplay with the project's underground mining component to achieve a safe, efficient, and cost-effective operation.

We are seeking approval for construction and development, with initial site works planned once approval is granted. A separate application will follow to allow for project modifications aimed at optimising operations since the original plan was submitted 2 years ago. Key proposed changes include:

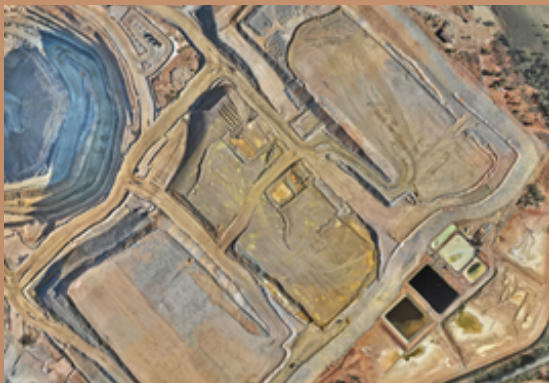
- Extending and deepening the open-cut pit;
- Increasing waste rock storage areas;
- Relocating and expanding infrastructure for mining, water management, and topsoil storage; and
- Increasing the potential solar farm footprint.



Most new infrastructure will be on existing cropped land, not native habitat. Updated studies will address biodiversity, water, heritage, air quality, and noise impacts.

Production may increase, which could mean minor changes to traffic movements. The modification application is expected to be submitted in early 2026.

Progress continues on Heap Leach Cells



Great progress is underway on the Heap Leach Cells as part of our site rehabilitation efforts. We're carefully and safely layering rock over the cells and the valleys between them to create the final landform. Each layer of the cover is tested to ensure proper drainage and compliance with rehabilitation standards.

NSW Government backs new tools for discovery at Tritton Operations



We've secured funding to drive smarter exploration and future copper discoveries

Our Tritton exploration team has secured \$70,000 in co-investment funding under the NSW Government's Critical Minerals and High-Tech Metals Strategy.

This investment highlights copper's critical role in powering the future - from renewable energy to technology - and supports exploration in underexplored regions.

The funding will enable a geophysical program at Tritton's Constellation Project, using gravity and IP surveys to better understand the deposit

and identify potential repeats in mineralisation nearby.

These techniques will help us target areas to drill more efficiently and give us new tools unlock future opportunities in the Girilambone Basin.

A big thanks to our exploration team for driving this forward.

Work kicks off early 2026 - another step toward smarter exploration and future discoveries.

Community Consultative Committee
