Cracow Gold Mine Tailings Storage Facility 2 Raise (Stage 3B, 4 and 5)

Resource activity: Mining activity relating to a mining lease

It is advised that Lion Mining Pty LTD has lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*. The environmental authority being amended is EPML00770913.

The application relates to Amendment for Environmental Authority (EA) - EPML00770913 to allow further raises. Stage 3B (1.5 m), Stage 4 (3.0 m), and Stage 5 (2.5 m) to extend TSF2's capacity by about five more years. These stages will increase the embankment height.

The resource activity is proposed to occur on the following tenure(s) and will involve:
